



Donation Guidelines

El Paso Children's Hospital provides services to seriously ill or injured children and teens. Our infection control guidelines prohibit us from accepting items that have been previously used. Furthermore, to protect the privacy of our patients and families, we do not allow groups to personally distribute gifts to children. Donations are distributed by hospital staff and volunteers.

We DO NOT accept:

- Latex balloons
- Books/toys with religious, violent, or political themes
- Any type of previously used or gently used toys, stuffed animals, clothing, books, etc.
- VHS tapes
- Cassette tapes

A donation drop-off may be scheduled with the Child Life Services by calling (915) 298-5444, ext. 43004. We ask that a donation drop-off be planned at least two weeks in advance. Donations are best accepted during business hours between 9:00AM and 5:00 PM.

A photo opportunity is offered in the Lobby and may be posted to El Paso Children's Hospital Facebook page for public acknowledgement of the donation. A Media Consent Form must be signed by anyone in the photograph. Media consents must be signed by parent/caregiver for any children under the age of 18.

You will be asked to fill out a Donation Acceptance Form and will receive a letter of acknowledgement from the El Paso Children's Hospital Foundation in the mail.
