INDICATIONS:	If questions specific to your diagnosis please contact your physician. Ultrasound of the breast can help to differentiate solid from cystic (fluid-filled) lesions in the breast tissue.	
CONTRAINDICATIONS:	None	
HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE?	The exam varies in length. From 30-45 minutes.	
PREPARATION:	If the patient has had previous mammograms or breast exams at other facilities they should obtain those BEFORE the scheduled exam and have them at the time of the exam. If the patient was given an order (prescription) for the exam they must have that with them at the time of the exam.	
PRECAUTIONS:	None	
MEDICATION ISSUES:	Take medication as usual.	
WHAT CAN BE EXPECTED:	During the exam there will be a gel placed on your skin in order to create an image. For certain areas the sonographer will need to apply more pressure than others. If you have any questions you may call the Imaging Department at 915-298-KIDS.
