

CONDITIONS TREATED BY

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HEAD/NECK

- Lymph nodes on front of neck (nothing on back of neck)
- Branchial cleft cysts
- Thyroglossal duct cysts
- Thyroidectomy

CHEST

- Central lines/ports placement and removals
- Congenital lung lesions
- Tracheo-esophageal fistula and esophageal atresia
- Spontaneous pneumothorax and recurrence or bleb bullae disease
- Pectus excavatum and carinatum
- Chest wall lesions

BREAST

- Breast masses
- Gynecomastia in boys

EXTREMITIES

- OK for lipomas and bumps, but no cysts around joints (wrist ganglion cyst or knee bakers cysts)

ABDOMEN

- Adrenal masses
- Appendix
- Anorectal malformations-imperforate anus
- Atresias-duodenal, small bowel, colonic
- Biliary atresia
- Choledochal cyst
- Gallbladder
- Gastroschisis

- Gastrostomy tubes/Jejunostomy tubes
- Hernias-umbilical and groin
- Hirschsprung disease
- Intestinal rotational abnormalities
- Intussusception
- Liver Masses/tumors
- Neuroblastoma
- Nissen fundoplication for refractory reflux
- Omphalocele
- Ovarian cysts and tumors
- Pyloric stenosis
- Renal tumors (Wilms)
- Splenic disorders
- Urachus and umbilical abnormalities

GU

- Circumcision-clinic 1 month and younger OR
- Undescended testicles

SKIN SOFT TISSUE

- Lipomas
- Hormone implants in arm (supprelin)
- Hidradenitis-axilla
- Pilonidal disease

PRENATALLY DIAGNOSED:

- Abdominal masses
- Duodenal atresia
- Dilated bowel
- Cloaca and anorectal malformation
- Congenital lung lesions
- Gastroschisis/omphalocele
