HEAD/NECK

- Lymph nodes
- Neck Masses
- Branchial cleft cysts
- Thyroglossal duct cysts
- Tongue-tie
- Thyroidectomy

CHEST

- Central lines/ports placement and removals
- Congenital lung lesions
- Tracheo-esophageal fistula and esophageal atresia
- Spontaneous pneumothorax and recurrence or bleb bullae disease
- Pectus excavatum and carinatum
- Chest wall lesions

BREAST

- Breast masses <16 years of age

GU

- Circumcision > 1 year OR
- Undescended testicles
- Hydrocele
- Inguinal hernia

SOFT TISSUE

- Lipomas/masses/abscesses/skin lesions
- Hormone implants
- Pilonidal disease

PRENATALLY DIAGNOSED:

- Intestinal Atresia

- Esophageal Atresia

- Pyloric stenosis
