COURSE DESCRIPTION

Surgical Course: This will be a comprehensive course which is focused on all aspects concerning the primary and secondary repair of cleft palate deformities. Experts will present the most common techniques for cleft palate repair, as well as, speech related surgeries. Topics will include a comparison of techniques including the Furlow Palatoplasty, the Bardach repair, and Von Lagenbach. Speech related surgeries will be addressed including revisional palatoplasty, sphincter pharyngoplasties, buccinator flaps for palatal lengthening, and pharyngeal flap surgery. All presenters will also present complications and pitfalls in cleft palatal repair. Additionally, a live surgery will be performed demonstrating the Furlow Palatoplasty Technique.

Nasoalveolar Molding Course: The purpose of this course will be to instruct willing learners in the art of Nasoalveolar Molding. This course is targeted to both beginners who are in the process of learning the technique, as well as, more seasoned professionals attempting to perfect their approach to NAM. The course will cover provide a hands on approach with lab work and fabrication of a NAM appliance. Real patient volunteers will be observed while receiving treatment and a thorough review of the process and appropriate treatment sequence will be provided.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

Surgical Course

- The Learner will understand the difference between the most common techniques for cleft palatal repair including: the Furlow, Von Lagenbeck, and Bardach.
- The Learner will learn how to recognize common cleft related speech disorders.
- The Learner will understand appropriate surgical techniques to appropriately treat cleft related speech disorders.
 The Learner will understand how to confidently handle common cleft palate surgical and postoperative complications.

NAM Course

- The Learner will be prepared to start providing NAM treatment at their cleft center.


