Our Neurosurgery team is dedicated to providing the best care to pediatric patients with neurosurgical needs through advanced surgical techniques. Conditions treated include brain and spinal cord tumors; Chiari malformations; craniosynostosis (minimally-invasive); spina bifida (open and occult); intracranial cysts; intracranial bleeds; skull tumors; defects and fractures; epilepsy, seizures and movement disorders; brain and spine trauma; congenital brain and spine deformities; and more.

CONDITIONS TREATED

The Pediatric Neurosurgery clinic specializes in the diagnosis and treatment of all neurosurgical conditions affecting the brain, spine, and nervous system to include:

- Epilepsy
- Spasticity
- Hydrocephalus
- Head and spine tumors
- Head and spine injuries
- Head and spine congenital malformations (e.g. encephaloceles, myelomeningocele, lipomyelomeningocele, tethered cord, others)
- Brain and spine vascular malformations (aneurysms, arteriovenous malformations, Moya Moya)
